(9) List 3 – 5 new skills you'll need to learn to carry out the project and how you'll acquire them
(10) Describe the final product (publication, video, PowerPoint, website, position paper, research report) you aim to produce and how you'll share it publicly

(11) Provide a month-by-month timeline for your work.
(12) Provide a project budget that itemizes your main, anticipated expenses, up to \$2,000—include the item, why you need it, and the approximate cost. We caution you that we're not keen on funding major equipment purchases.
